Burial fees will be claimed directly from CFF by Gardens of Peace

Note – The cut off point for booking a same day burial is **11:30am**. Please ensure payment is made before burial takes place. (Cash/credit card payments are not accepted, only personal debit cards and direct bank transfers)

The above Burial Fees are fully inclusive of the cost of wood planks which must be used for the grave and includes, for Grave Areas BB, CA and Adult, the cost of supplying and fixing a grave marker. A maintenance fee of £50.00 per annum is chargeable.

The method of burial at the Cemetery is in shrouds **without coffin** in accordance with Sunnah, except where required for medical reasons.

There is a charge of £210 for the burial of body parts, such as limbs.

** A foetus from 17 weeks + 1 day (120 days) must be given a name in accordance with Sharī'ah – where the sex of the child cannot be determined then a neutral name suitable for boys and girls must be given. Note that this is a general guide; in accordance with Shariah a name must be given to a foetus when its limbs have taken form.*

Guidance Notes

Letting us know

Please let us know by 11.30am if you require a same day funeral/burial (subject to availability of burial slot). This will allow us sufficient time to prepare the grave and carry out all necessary preparation ready for your funeral. If you contact Gardens of Peace after this time, then it may not be possible to accommodate the funeral/burial.

Facilities available

- Men's prayer area – maximum 100 capacity (*Janāzah Salāh* by prior agreement)
- Women's prayer area – maximum 30 capacity
- Mortuary (use is subject to daily charge of £50)
- Separate toilet and Wudu facilities for men and women
- Office area – for completion of paperwork

Prompt attendance at the Cemetery

Funeral Directors should arrive promptly so that other planned funerals and burials are not delayed. Please let us know as soon as possible if you expect delay, we will do our best to accommodate. There is a charge for late funerals of £250 to cover staff and other costs that we incur.

All burials must be completed by 4pm.

Cancellations

A grave may already have been prepared so when a cancellation takes place, we must do additional work to prevent the prepared grave from collapsing so that it can be used in future. There is a charge of £200 to cover the cost of doing this.

Food at the Cemetery

We do not allow the distribution/consumption of food and drink on site for a range of reasons, not least because the Cemetery is busy with multiple funerals and burials taking place in a short period of time. To allow this would cause operational issues and inconvenience to other mourners.

Order of funerals

Funerals and burials are undertaken in the order in which they have been booked. If your funeral arrives early, we may ask you to wait to allow funerals and burials booked earlier to be undertaken.

Equipment storage

We are sometimes asked to store equipment (usually coffins). We do not have specific provision for this, but we will do our best to accommodate for a short period of time either under cover or outside in our yard which may subject the equipment to poor weather conditions. We cannot accept any liability for loss or damage arising as a result of such storage.
